VII. VOTE REGARDING DISPOSITION OF ADDITIONAL STATE SUBSIDY AND REVISED WARRANTS AND INSTALLMENTS

- 1. Whereas, on May 24, 2017, Regional School Unit No. 14 (the "RSU") adopted its fiscal year 2017-18 budget, and on June 13, 2017, the RSU ratified that budget at Budget Validation Referendum (hereinafter, the "Approved Budget");

Whereas, the Approved Budget included Article 19, authorizing the School Board of the RSU to use all of any additional state subsidy received after approval of the Approved Budget to increase expenditures for school purposes in cost center categories approved by the School Board; increase the allocation of finances in a reserve fund approved by the School Board; and/or decrease the local cost share expectation, as defined in Title 20-A, section 15671-A (1)(B), for local property taxpayers for funding public education as approved by the School Board;

Whereas, pursuant to the Maine Department of Education ED279 Report for funding public education, dated February 16, 2017, the state subsidy amount reported and used for revenue for the Approved Budget was **\$14,559,431.26**;

Whereas, on or about July 4, 2017, the Legislature enacted the biennial budget bill including additional funding for public education;

Whereas, pursuant to the Maine Department of Education ED279 Report for funding public education, dated July 18, 2017, the RSU will receive state subsidy in the amount of **\$15,223,650.68**, an amount which is **\$664,219.42** greater than the **\$14,559,431.26** state subsidy amount reported for revenue on the February 16, 2017 ED279 Report and used for the Approved Budget; and

Whereas, pursuant to Public Law 2017, Chapter 284, section JJJJJJ-5 and related guidance from the Maine Department of Education, the School Board is authorized to use the additional state subsidy as authorized by Article 19 of the Budget Meeting;

Now therefore, the Board of Directors of the RSU hereby votes to allocate the additional state subsidy as follows:

\$120,200.00 to increase the 2017-2018 appropriation for Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment Cost Center.

\$168,646.02 to reduce the Town of Raymond’s education tax assessment for the 2017-2018 fiscal year; and

\$375,373.40 to reduce the Town of Windham’s education tax assessment for the 2017-2018 fiscal year.
